Year 6 children are all invited to apply for roles in school from Digital Leaders, Play Leaders to Mental Health Ambassadors to Librarians – all invited to take on a role and responsibility in our school. We are proud of them all.

Zones of Regulation – The Inclusion Team continue to lead the zones across school and talk to children each day about their emotions. We aim to support children to regulate and use a range of strategies across school to ensure our children are heard and their feelings taken on board.

Harriett (our Senior Mental Health Lead from the NHS) continues to work in school every Monday with families and our team to continue to provide the best possible support for mental health and well-being in our school.

We were extremely excited to receive the Asceed Accreditation for the next 3 years! Mental Health and well-being at the heart of our school.



Adswood Superpowers - Each lesson and through daily life in school our children evaluate their learning and talk about the Adswood Superpowers. From focus, determination, kindness – a range of superpowers are part of our everyday life in Adswood and develop children's awareness of values and what they represent. Ask your child what superpowers they have used today in school?

Gold Standard – Each day children write in school, mainly in English but also across a range of subjects each day. We introduced the 'Gold Standard' 12 months ago and have seen a vast improvement in the presentation of our children's work – not just in writing but across other subjects. They take pride in their work and are always eager to share learning with other teachers, the leadership team and visitors. We look forward to sharing their books with you at our next Parents Evening in March. Ask your child about gold standard writing!

We continue to forward Holiday club sessions via seesaw provided by other external providers off site including Stockport County, Forest Schools, Meadowbank Sports club and more.
